Portable Long Service!

The NSW Government has officially launched the Community Services Industry (CSI) Portable Long Service Leave Scheme, a major milestone for our sector. From 1 July 2025, eligible workers in the community services sector (that's us) will be able to accrue long service leave entitlements even if they change employers within the industry. This long-awaited reform recognises the vital contributions of our workforce and supports greater job security and retention across the sector.



Recycle Mate: Your Smart Recycling Companion

Recycle Mate is a free app developed to help Australians understand what can and can't be recycled in their local area. It uses a photo recognition tool and a location-based database to provide specific recycling advice for individual items based on local council rules — it could be for recycling, reuse, or safe disposal.

The app's current database covers over 5,000 items and integrates information from more than 500 local councils, it is growing every day as more communities become involved and more data is added.

With features like barcode scanning and multilingual support in 89 languages, Recycle Mate is an invaluable tool for reducing landfill waste and promoting sustainable practices nationwide - check it out.
